2021 Event Sponsorship Opportunities

Annual Fundraising Reception (Giving levels of \$5,000 - \$500)

- Averages 200 guests; we held this event virtually in 2020 with no significant change in attendance
- Springtime event, after work on a Thursday
- 5:30 – 7:30 with sit-down program (virtual event was 45 minutes). No tickets for guests to attend.
- Historically this event has included heavy hors d'oeuvres and drinks for guests at the Albany Golf & Event Center
- 2021 will be the 8th annual event (will be virtual)

Annual Open House & Awareness Events for the Community

(Giving levels of \$500 - \$100)

- Approximately 100 guests per event
- After work on a weekday
- Open House Events are drop-in and happen every-other-year at a 24/7 Shelter: Albany House (2021)
- November is National Runaway Prevention Month

General Operational Support from our Business Partners for Youth:

- Last year, nearly 800 youth found safety, stability, positive adult relationships, access to mental health services, educational and life-skill support through Jackson Street's Outreach, 24/7 Shelters, and Next Steps services.

2021 Program Sponsorship Opportunities

Activity Sponsor (Giving level of \$2,000)

- Youth in 24/7 Shelter and Aftercare programs are offered activity experiences that build confidence and explore new interest and hobbies.
- Activities range from music and arts to outdoor adventures to educational instruction.

PS(541) Linn County (Giving level of \$2,000) **CLAIMED!**

PS(541) Benton County (Giving level of \$2,000)

- These life skills classes cover topics from financial health and basic budgeting, to home maintenance, to self-care, to continued education opportunities.
- This program is required for young adults in our Next Steps housing and is also open to community youth.
- PS(541) stands for Peer Support and our local (541) area code.

Queer Peers (Giving level of \$2,000)

- Queer Peers is an LGBTQ+ social and support group which meets regularly in Albany; a meal is provided.
- LGBTQ+ youth are 120% more likely to experience homelessness than their peers.
